FESTIVAL INFORMATION

Dimensions and Outlook Festivals are underground music festivals with a higher technical specification of sound system than you will find at any other festivals of their size. Dimensions is the perfect place to enjoy the deep end of electronica, the finest in house, techno, world, disco, dubstep and other electronic sounds; while Outlook is approaching its tenth year of celebrating Soundsystem Culture.

VOLUNTEER PACKAGE

3 x 6-8 hour shifts or 1 x 12 hour shift and 1 x 6-8 hour shift*

In exchange for your Festival Ticket, Camping Pass (if required) and 3 x Food Vouchers (one per shift)

** Shift patterns subject to role allocation. Volunteers are unable to choose their preferred pattern.*

OUTLOOK VOLUNTEERING DATES

Tuesday 5th until Monday 11th September

Please note, all volunteers are required to arrive on-site and be issued with their wristband/s the day BEFORE their first shift.

APPLICATION INFORMATION

There are a variety of different roles on offer across both events including, but not limited to stewarding, litter picking, stage management, artist liaison, and welfare. You will be allocated your role based on the information you supply in your application.

Please note, applications will only be processed once we have received two professional references from the contacts you provide in your application.

The closing date for Local Volunteer Applications is Friday 21st July 2017.

VOLUNTEERS CAMPING

Volunteers are entitled to a Volunteer Camping Pass at Camp Brioni which is the festival campsite.

All volunteers camp in our general campsite. This enables volunteers to camp with their friends who are attending the festival as customers.

You are required to bring your own tent, along with all the things you need to go in it. Alternatively, you can purchase a tent for collection when you arrive on-site, via the [BOOK NOW](#) section of our website. There are also several shops on-site where you can purchase camping mats and sleeping bags. Volunteers are welcome to book Boutique Camping, Hostel Rooms or a Mobile Home. These types of accommodation are not included in the volunteer package so must be purchased via the customer website.

TRAVELING TO FORT PUNTA CHRISTO

Volunteers are responsible for booking and funding their travel to the site. You are advised to book your travel as soon as possible as flights, trains, and coaches tend to be cheaper the earlier you book. Airport Transfers, Shuttles and Coach Travel Packages can be booked via the [TRAVEL](#) page on our website.

Please remember that all volunteers are required to arrive on-site and be accredited the day before their first shift. The campsite is open to all volunteers from midday on Tuesday 29th August 2017 for Dimensions Festival and midday on Tuesday 5th September 2017 for Outlook Festival.

ROLE AND SHIFT INFORMATION

All successful volunteers will be emailed their Volunteer Advance two weeks prior to their arrival on-site.

Please do not contact us asking for role and shift information, we will not be able to answer you as we are producing the rota for all 1,500 of you!

Unfortunately, we are unable to take requests for volunteers to work with their friends, owing to the fact we are such a large operation. It would simply become a logistical nightmare to consider individual volunteer requests.

Please note, all Amphitheatre and Boat Party tickets are brought at your own risk. We are unable to fit rotas around Amphitheatre and Boat Party requests. If you have purchased an Amphitheatre or Boat Party ticket and you have been scheduled to volunteer at the same time, we will allow you one free name change per ticket to enable you to sell or swap your ticket.

As a Volunteer, you are accredited daily, you will receive your full festival wristband once you have completed your final shift. If you fail to complete all your shifts you will not be issued with your full festival wristband and will not be granted access to the site. You will also be blacklisted from all future events. If there is a legitimate reason for your absence, please speak to a member of the Volunteer Management Team on-site.

LOCAL VOLUNTEER TIMELINE

1. Submit your Volunteer Application via our online form which can be found [HERE](#)
2. Notify your references that we will be contacting them about your position.
3. Reply to the Local Volunteer Coordinator's email to confirm your place.
4. When required, submit your travel details to the Volunteer Management Team (they will email you).
5. Read your Volunteer Advance which includes your shift times and role information. This will be sent out two weeks prior to your arrival on-site.
6. Arrive on-site, complete your shifts and have fun!
